General

Family File Crate: This can be the Rubbermaid Crate-A-File or a Letter/Legal File Box with a lid.

Each class will require a homework folder - with pockets (prongs if desired), based on the following color code:

Red – English (matching 1” 3-ring binder) Literary Synthesis

Blue – Cultulative History (matching 1” 3-ring binder)

Yellow – Foreign Language (Latin)

Green – Logic (matching ½ “ 3-ring binder), Rhetoric (black 2” 3-ring binder)

Orange – General Science, Engineering, Anatomy, Earth Science, Biology, Chemistry, Physics

Purple – Theater Arts

These are to be solid color pocket folders only. They must be clearly labeled on the front in black marker designating Student Name, Level and Class
(Parents may use the prongs to keep a record of the student’s grades if desired.)

For all classes students will need:
