What do I do next?

1. Order Tests

You can order tests by calling Bob Jones University Press at 1-800-845-5731.

-OR You can order on-line at their website <http://www.bjupress.com/services/testing>

- Click on **“Place an Order”**, scroll to bottom of page,
- Click on **“Browse the Catalog”**
- Click on **“Achievement/Abilities Tests”**
- Click on **“Stanford Tests”**, then scroll down to **“Stanford/TASK Achievement Tests (K5-Grade 12 – Click for Full List)”**.

Order the test that corresponds to your child's grade level for the Spring of 2010. This is the grade level that your child is finishing.

Do NOT order the OLSAT combined test.

**FYI: We will NOT be administering
Primary 1 tests (1st grade).**

2. Register with PACES

You **MUST** register your students with Denise Gens to reserve a spot for test administration.

E-mail dgens@cebridge.net

Include the following information: Put "SAT testing" in subject line.

- Student's name, birth date and test grade level
- Parent's name, address and phone number
- Cell phone number (for emergency use only)
- e-mail address.

Bob Jones University Press does **NOT** notify us of who is testing until tests are actually sent, so to assure that we have enough space and administrators, you **MUST** notify PACES when you order your tests.

What is the cost for testing?

We charge **\$35.00** to administer each test. (payable to PACES). This is due on the day of testing.

Bob Jones University Press charges **\$40.00** for each test.

This includes the "rental" of the test, scoring of the test, and a report mailed *directly to the parents*.

What do we bring on test day?

Each student will need:

- 3+ sharpened #2 pencils with erasers
- a book to read if they finish early
- a snack and drink for the break between tests.

High Schoolers grades 9-12:

The use of a calculator will be allowed. Please bring a calculator with you.

When will we get the test results?

The test results will be mailed **directly to the family** approximately 6 to 8 weeks after they are returned to BJUP for scoring. We send tests back about 1 week after testing, and it takes a few days for the tests to be shipped. If you have not received your results by that time, you may contact BJUP to see if they have been mailed. If you need test results **faster** than that, you may pay BJUP an extra \$25.00 for hand scoring. The hand-scoring method will take about 3 weeks.

Testing Day Information:

Please arrive by 8:45am on Tuesday to help facilitate an on-time start for testing!
As soon as you arrive, check in with your child's tester and pay the \$35.00 administration fee.

Checks are to be made payable to:
"PACES".

Locate your grade level room assignment.

Parents may leave during testing. After testing, students will come directly to you.

Please do not enter the classroom to locate your kids - this will disturb the students that are still testing!
